This document is intended to be an adjunct to the pages on the web site about the area around Tower Hill.

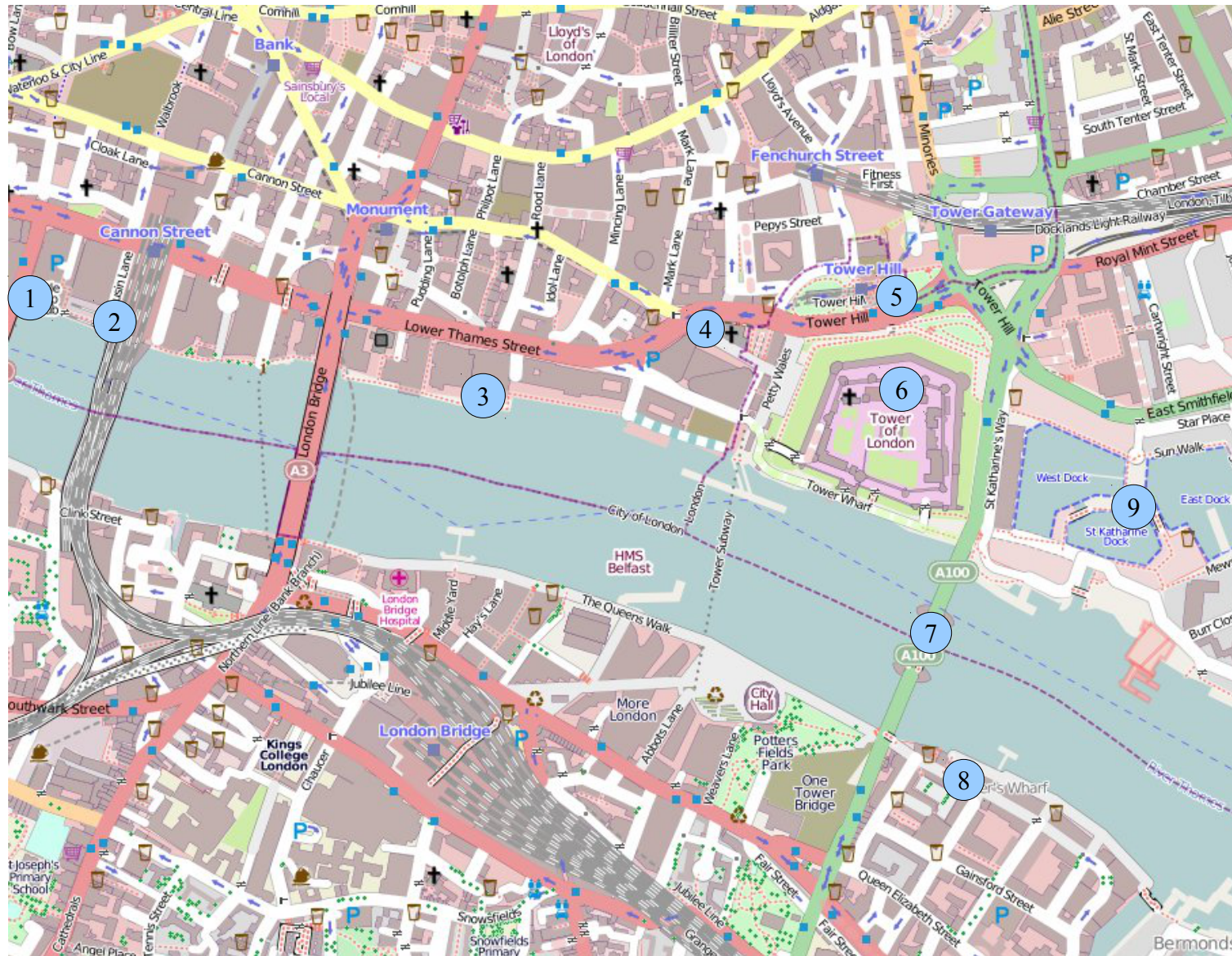
The numbers on the maps are not intended to give an order of visiting but just to enable labelling. You decide on your own route. Underground stations are labelled in blue lettering and station entrances are marked with a blue square somewhere near the title. For example – on the first map just above the figure 5 is the label for 'Tower Hill' station with the blue blocks marking the entrances to the left of the figure 5.

The second map is the continuation of the first map from its right-hand edge and they overlap a little. You could tape them together if you wish.

Key to the labels:

1. Fruiterer's Passage near Southwark Bridge.
2. Steelyard Passage under Cannon Street Station.
3. Old Billingsgate Fruit Market.
4. The Church of All Hallows by the Tower.
5. Part of the Roman Wall.
6. Tower of London.
7. Tower Bridge.
8. Shad Thames.
9. St. Catherine's Dock.
10. Entrance to the basin and old canal, Wapping.
11. The old canal, Wapping.
12. Tobacco Dock.
13. Shadwell Basin.
14. The Prospect of Whitby pub and the old Hydraulic Power Station.
15. The Captain Kidd pub.
16. The Town of Ramsgate pub.
